



Policies for Phase Three

Beginning Friday July 1, 2020

- All customers visiting the winery must be over 21 years old (no infants, toddlers, or teenagers). Each party is limited to 10 guests each. Each party will have a 2-hour window to enjoy their on-site experience. Groups of 6-10 will need to make a reservation with a deposit prior to arrival.
- *Pet policy updated!! You can now bring your furry family members, with a few caveats:
 1. They need to be on a leash 6 feet (or shorter) at all times
 2. They are welcome in our lower field ONLY
 3. They should be well-behaved, and resist barking at other dogs or guests
 4. They should remain 6ft away from other guests, just like their human parents
- Please check in with the tasting room when you arrive, before being seated at a table or using the bathroom.
- Only our outdoor seating will be open for customers, rain or shine. We have a limited number of tables on our covered patio, and several picnic tables in our field.
 - ❖ Please do not move the tables... 6 ft physical distancing must be maintained.
 - ❖ No pop-up tents
- Face covering is required for transiting the property and entering the building (including for the use of the bathrooms).
- We will be offering Bottle Sales, Flights of Wine (aka DIY tasting), and Wine by the Glass. There are 3 ways for you to enjoy your wine on our property:
 - ❖ Disposable plastic cups ... these are Free
 - ❖ We'll have logo glasses for sale for \$3 each, and you'll take those home with you
 - ❖ You can bring your favorite glass from home, and then take it back home at the end of your visit.
- We encourage you to bring a picnic. Just remember the following:
 - ❖ NO alcohol is permitted on the property besides what we sell you here (that's Virginia Law)
 - ❖ NO large/rolling coolers.... Keep it small and compact.
- CurbSide Pick-up is still available. Call (703) 737-3930 to place your order.
- Bottles-To-Go and Slushies-To-Go will be available in the tasting room.
